AGREEMENT FOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR MYSELF OR MY MINOR CHILD

I request permission for myself or my minor child, named below, to participate in cross-country riding and foxhunting with the Wentworth Hunt. I fully understand that cross-country horseback riding and foxhunting (which includes riding over fences, other obstacles, and over steep and rough terrain) are very dangerous activities. I wish to allow my child or to be allowed myself to participate in these activities knowing they are dangerous. I accept and assume all the risks of injury (including death) for myself or my child or to my property. I represent and warrant that I have the authority to give this release.

In exchange for myself or my child being permitted to participate in these activities, for myself, for my child, my heirs, my child's heirs, guardians, and legal representatives, I release and agree not to make or bring any claim of any kind against the Wentworth Hunt, or its masters, officers, directors, members, employees, or guests or any landowners, landholders or other persons making property available for the Wentworth Hunt, for any injury (including death) to myself or to my child or any damage to my property whether from anyone's negligence or not, or any other cause, arising out of my participation or my child's participation in these dangerous horseback riding, fox hunting or related activities; and I also agree if anyone makes any claims because of any injury to myself or my child (including death), or for any damage to my property, I will keep all those released by this agreement free of any damages or costs because of those claims.

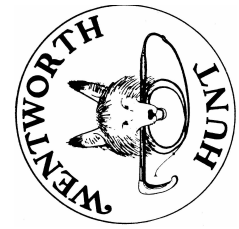

POINTS OF ETIQUETTE FOR FOX HUNTING
LANDOWNERS: Be respectful of all property you ride over. Do not ride on non-hunting days without permission. Close what you open (gates), put up what you take down (rails), repair and report what you damage. **Please personally thank the landowners if they are at the meet.**
HOUNDS: Hounds have right of way at all times. Say "Ware Hound" to horse and rider. Never interfere or call to hounds. No talking while hounds are drawing scent.
STAFF: Honor the Master of Foxhounds and Field Masters' requests and directions always. Staff has the right of way at all times. When you hear "Staff, Please", turn your horse to face staff – back off trail as they pass. Stay behind your Field Master. If you wish to move to another field (i.e., from hilltop to first flight or vice versa), request move to both Field Masters.
RIDERS: Please be prompt and ready to move off with hounds at time designated on fixture card. Have your horse under control at all times. Otherwise, for everyone's safety, retire to the trailer area. Train your horse at home – no lunging or lunge whips permitted at meets. Show every consideration to someone on a young or inexperienced horse. Take your turn at jumps. If your horse refuses, move on. School at home.

MEMBERS: Greet and welcome all newcomers and be as helpful and friendly as you can. Ride with the guests you bring, imparting as much information as you can regarding protocol. Introduce your guest to the Masters & Field Master.
ATTIRE: Cub Season – Jackets of conservative tweed, plaid or muted color; shirt, tie, breeches of conservative color; tall boots, hard hat. In hot weather, white polo shirt may replace hacking jacket. No eventing type gear – e.g., colored box pads or helmet covers. Formal Season – Dark jacket, white shirt, stock tie with plain pin; buff, grey, or tan breeches; black boots, hard hat. No colored eventing gear.

Protective Vest Acceptable under Jacket.

- ALL RIDERS MUST SEEK OUT FIELD SECRETARY UPON ARRIVAL AND BE CHECKED IN.
- CAPPERS PLACE FEE IN WHITE ENVELOPE WITH NAME AND ADDRESS ON FRONT.
- EVERY RIDER MUST SIGN A WAIVER.
- MEMBERSHIP DUES MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE RIDING.
